
The following points were discussed as per agenda:

1. Prof B.M. Vadher gave progress review of trainings under taken by students of Electrical, Mechanical and EC of final and pre-final year of this institute and nearby Govt. Engg. Colleges & polytechnics. The total number of students trained is 2424.
2. Financial Review-Grant allotted for COE expenses and account summary as on 12th April 2017 was discussed.
3. Shri. Nishit Bhatt discussed about training mechanism courses which are designed and conducted at this institute. Need to develop mechanism of training SFI faculty and students was discussed by him.

4. Review of trainings undertaken by faculty of Govt. Engg. Colleges and Polytechnics in 2016-2017 were briefed by Prof. V. D. Dhiman.
 5. Prof. V. S. Purani suggested preparing a percentage mapping between GTU syllabus and the CoE courses.
 6. He also suggested getting an academic autonomy with GTU if major changes are required in the teaching schemes to justify the investment on establishment of Centers of Excellence.
 7. Details of faculties trained in various CoE Laboratories should be prepared; faculty should be able to conduct training programs independently and conduct pedagogy at department level on completion of training.
 8. Proposals for various training courses, module wise depending on number of duration for minimum batch strength of 30 students, the fees of Rs. 2000/- per student for 45 hours of duration to be charged for SFI students and to be submitted to CTE for approval.
 9. Prof. B. M. Vadher discussed about CoE communication carried out with Industry Commissioner to surrender the grant as per Audit para (AG Rajkot).
 10. Shri D.R.Patel suggested collecting completion certificates from R&B.
 11. Prof. Shyam Varghese, Deputy Director-CTE, discussed about STTPs proposed in next term (for faculty members of government degree and polytechnic colleges during vacation period) under CoE and necessary proposals submitted well in advance.
